

Contract - Offer on participation at the International Conference 2020 Ural
Symposium on Biomedical Engineering, Radioelectronics and Information
Technology (USBEREIT)

This document, posted on the Internet at <https://usbereit.ieeesiberia.org/> by Individual Entrepreneur Khazankin Grigory Romanovich (Primary State Registration Number 317547600062854, Individual Taxpayer Number 025600202755, work settlement Koltsovo) hereinafter referred to as the “Contractor”, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 437 of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation, is a public offer, that is, the Contractor’s proposal to conclude a paid informational services and services of organization of remote participation at the International Conference 2020 Ural Symposium on Biomedical Engineering, Radioelectronics and Information Technology (USBEREIT) (hereinafter - the “Agreement”) with an individual (hereinafter - the “Customer”) intending to take part in the above mentioned conference.

The agreement shall be deemed to have been executed between the Contractor and the Customer at the time of acceptance by the Customer the Contractor’s public offer. Payment of registration fee by the participant of the conference to the Contractor’s current account is an acceptance of the public offer - the conclusion of this Agreement on the conditions set forth below.

SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

1. The Customer agrees to assign, and the Contractor assumes informational services and services of organization of remote participation at the International Conference 2020 Ural Symposium on Biomedical Engineering, Radioelectronics and Information Technology (USBEREIT).
2. The Contractor is obliged to provide consulting services for organizational support of carrying out the International Conference, provide the Customer with a conference program on the website <https://usbereit.ieeesiberia.org/> and forward the materials presented at the conference to IEEE Xplore for further publication.
3. The Conference participant is obliged to transfer the registration fee to the Contractor until May 21 2020. The amount of registration fee for the participants of the conference: IEEE members - 4 000 (four thousand) Russian rubles; not IEEE members – 5 000 (five thousand) Russian rubles. Payment for Services is carried out by cashless money transfer to the Contractor’s account for each paper presented at the conference. The Customer’s obligation to pay for the Services shall be considered to be fulfilled from the moment the funds are received at the Contractor’s account.
4. The date of the conference is May14-15 2020.
5. The Contractor’s services shall be considered to be rendered at the time of online report of the presentation at the conference.

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

6. The Contractor is obliged:
 - 6.1. To organize a conference online, to prepare a conference proceedings and a conference program for publication..
 - 6.2. To provide the Customer with the opportunity to remotely participate in the Conference by the site <https://usbereit.ieeesiberia.org/>.
 - 6.3. To inform the Customer about the results of reviewing and acceptance of the submitted materials.
7. Rights of the Contractor:
 - 7.1. To decline the submitted materials in the case of receiving a negative review
 - 7.2. To determine the amount of the registration fee, based on the costs for organizing the conference, consulting services for organizational support of carrying out the Conference preparing a conference proceedings and publishing the conference program.
8. The Customer Responsibilities:
 - 8.1. To abide by the terms of this agreement.
 - 8.2. To comply with deadlines and requirements for submitted and presented materials, published at <https://usbereit.ieeesiberia.org>.

OTHER CONDITIONS

9. The article should be presented at the conference in the form of a report online. Papers that will not be presented at the conference will not be published.
10. Papers that do not meet the IEEE requirements for submissions may not be published in IEEE Xplore. If the discrepancy is found after the transfer of publication rights to IEEE, the conference organizers do not bear responsibility for the refusal of IEEE to publish the article. The registration fee is not returned to the participant in this case.

FINAL PROVISIONS

11. Disputes arising during the execution of this Agreement shall be resolved through negotiations. If no consent is reached, disputes under this Agreement shall be considered by the court in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation.
12. This agreement comes into force from the date of its acceptance by the Conference Participant and is valid until the parties fulfill their obligations.
